### **Technical**

- Released a new Ritual+Catalyst generation system in the Beta CMA to assist logistics teams in the creation of these items for treasure.
- AMS development.
- Website rebranding activities.

The team may be seeking additional members soon familiar with JavaScript. While they are able to train people, they anticipate looking only for those able to hit the ground running.

For the past two months, the National staff has mainly been focused on the 2.1 proposed ruleset. On August 24th, the owners held a virtual Special Meeting to discuss and vote on whether to incorporate the finalized ARC-submitted 2.1 package into the official Alliance LARP ruleset. Ultimately, [that vote failed](#). The ownership has directed the National staff to resume making adjustments to the ruleset with an emphasis on soliciting additional feedback from players through playtests.
