Summer is here! Events have started running again! If you're a player of Alliance LARP, there is a lot to get excited for in the coming months. The National staff continues to make progress on future updates and projects. Here's a projected timeline for a few of the big things we have in the pipeline:

- Bylaws update - these revisions are still under owner review. Once finalized, the bylaws will be posted publicly.
- 2.1 updates - a pre-proposal has been submitted for owner feedback. Work on this will continue until a full proposal is ready, targeting the end of July.
- ARB and APG rewrites from the Documents committee - end of July target.
