Rules

This month, ARC reviewed submissions from Design, including new rituals and items under the “Superior” project. Work also continued on integrating owner feedback into the 2.1 alpha packet.

Diversity

The new lead of the Diversity Committee, Justin M., officially started this month. The team is currently working to put together a code of conduct and a document on playing fair.

Publicity

Publicity worked to edit together a video log of the Owner’s Symposium for the national staff to reference. Scheduled posts through the end of the year on Alliance Larp’s [Facebook Page](#) are being worked on. Planning is currently being done for the 2.1 marketing launch in 2022 when the beta packet is ready for public distribution.

Design

Design continues to work on rituals and items for the 2.1 project “Superior”. Several new ritual ideas were created this month, and existing ideas were sent to ARC for review.

Documents

The Documents team is working on their second run through of the rulebook and integrating information from the Player’s Guide into it. They are also finalizing an official Alliance LARP Code of Conduct and changes to the bylaws voted in at the Owner’s Symposium.
